Mr. Alperstein has successfully represented institutional investors in securities fraud and derivative actions seeking damages related to the origination and servicing of residential mortgage-backed securities. In addition, Mr. Alperstein represents individuals in consumer class actions seeking damages, declaratory judgments, and injunctive relief as a result of consumer fraud, unfair methods of competition, and unconscionable, deceptive, and unfair trade practices. Mr. Alperstein has been featured in *The Daily Business Review* and was recently selected as a 2014 Florida Super Lawyer Rising Star.

Currently, Mr. Alperstein serves on the team of lawyers that has been appointed lead or co-lead counsel in nationwide and statewide class action lawsuits against dozens of the largest banking institutions in connection with the unlawful assessment of checking account overdraft fees. To date, his efforts have resulted in over \$250 million in settlements for his clients and significant changes in the way banks charge overdraft fees to their customers. Mr. Alperstein also has experience representing both plaintiffs and defendants in business litigation disputes involving trademark infringement, theft of trade secrets, fraudulent and negligent misrepresentation, breach of fiduciary duty, breach of contract, tortious interference, and commercial real estate litigation.

In connection with his representation in securities fraud, derivative and class action matters, Mr. Alperstein has litigated cases in multiple state and federal jurisdictions throughout the country, including multi-district litigation proceedings. In addition to being admitted to practice throughout all state courts in Florida and New York, Mr. Alperstein is admitted to practice in the United States District Courts for the Northern, Middle and Southern Districts of Florida, Southern and Eastern Districts of New York, Eastern District of Michigan, and Northern District of Illinois. He has also been admitted to practice in many other federal district courts and state courts throughout the country on a temporary basis, including in California, Pennsylvania and Tennessee. Mr. Alperstein is a member of the Business Law and Trial Lawyers sections of The Florida Bar, as well as the Commercial & Federal Litigation and Trial Lawyers sections of the New York State Bar Association.
